By Entrance Location

Turk: Kindergarten & Students in Supervision

East Door (near play structure): Enter on Elm off of Pierce ~Grades 2, 3, & 4

West Door (Near Garden): Enter on Elm off of Scott~Middle School

The Ramp (middle of yard): Enter on Elm off of Pierce ~ Grades 1 & 5

DO NOT drive down either ELM St. Alley***

Dismissal

- **Dismissal by Entrance (same as arrival)**
 - **Turk**: Kindergarten & Students in Supervision
 - **East Door (near play structure)**: Grades 2, 3, & 4
 - **West Door (Near Garden)**: Middle School
 - **The Ramp (middle of yard)**: Grades 1 & 5
 - **Dismissal by Grade/Time**
 - Kinder: 2:15pm
 - 1 & 2: 2:30pm
 - 3, 4, & 5: 2:45pm
 - Middle School: 3:05pm
 - Supervision: remote learning schedule by grade level
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Arrival & Dismissal for Siblings

- Siblings may arrive & depart together
 - Please use whichever entrance your YOUNGEST student is assigned to for both drop off and pick up
 - We will have very short-term before and after school care for students who have siblings and need to arrive early or depart late.
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Items Needed Daily

- Computer, tablet, or other device
 - Headphones if they have their own
 - Basic school supplies
 - Water bottle
 - Lunch, unless they are having school lunch
 - Their own snacks (we have back-up if they forget)
 - A properly fitting face mask
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Safety Guidelines

Masks

- Required 100% of the time except when eating and drinking
- Students without masks will be provided one and required to wear it

Violations

- Students who refuse to wear their masks and have been reminded more than twice, will be sent home for the remainder of the day for remote learning
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Safety Guidelines

Hand Hygiene

- Students must sanitize or wash hands regularly; this has been built into their schedules

Social Distancing

- Students must keep distance between themselves and their classmates and staff members to every extent possible

By sending your student back to in-person learning, you acknowledge that there is risk of COVID-19 transmission involved.

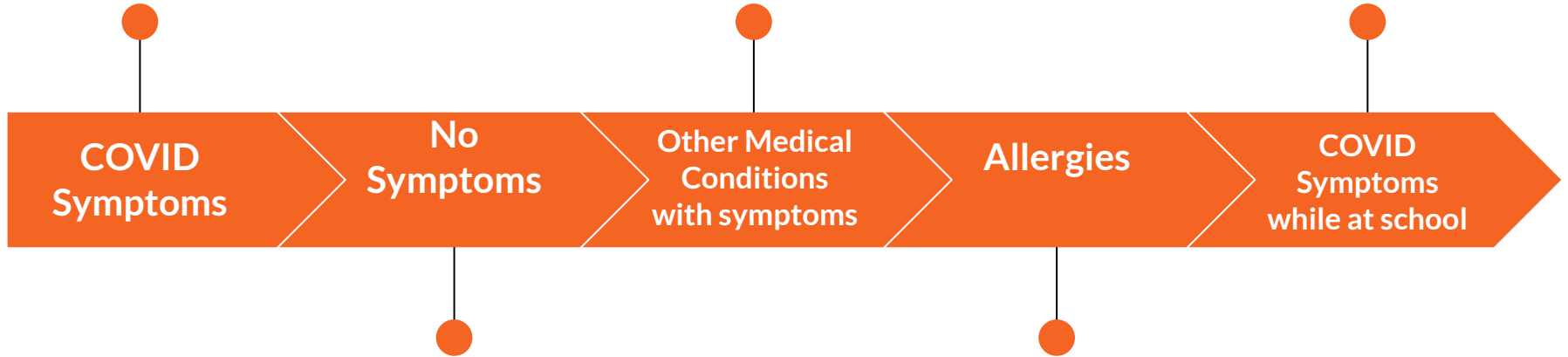
